Proposed By-Law Change

Proposed by Al Bloom, NIAL

I move that we change section 6 of the SCRA bylaws, which currently reads:

6. One fifth of the voting membership shall constitute a quorum at general meetings. Four voting Directors shall constitute a quorum of the Board.

To read:

6. One tenth of the voting membership shall constitute a quorum at general meetings. The quorum for Board meetings shall be four voting Directors or one half of the currently serving voting Directors, whichever is less.

This change will avoid the problem we had at the November 1997 general club meeting where we did not have enough members present to vote on new officers.

The change in the quorum for Board meetings allows for the possibility of missing Directors. As it is now, if more than half the Board were no longer serving (through resignation, death, etc.) Then the Board could not legally hold a meeting.
