



SCOTT

Several friends have expressed interest in the regulator circuit in my homebrew power supply. Thanks to the efforts of WAGRNF, Terry and Novice to be Joe Stans, the following information shows the final result. Can't give you all the whys and wherefores, but can tell you that it works beautifully. The circuit should work with just about any current requirements up to and including 25 amps.

MATERIALS: D-1 to D-4 Bridge Rectifier. Radio Shack #276-1185 25A #276-2041 12A


C-1 3000mfd per amp, output current

Load Resistor (not shown, installed accross output) 200 ohms 10 watts

Heat sinks on Q1, Q2 Radio Shack 267-1361

T-1 Transformer 18v sec. Capable of handling current desired.

NOTE: I have many transformers capable of 3 to 10 amps. See me if you need one. Also have hundreds of ne diodes. Have the PC board if you wish to make a copy. If you need further help, let me know and if I can't help, I know someone who can. Good Luck.
