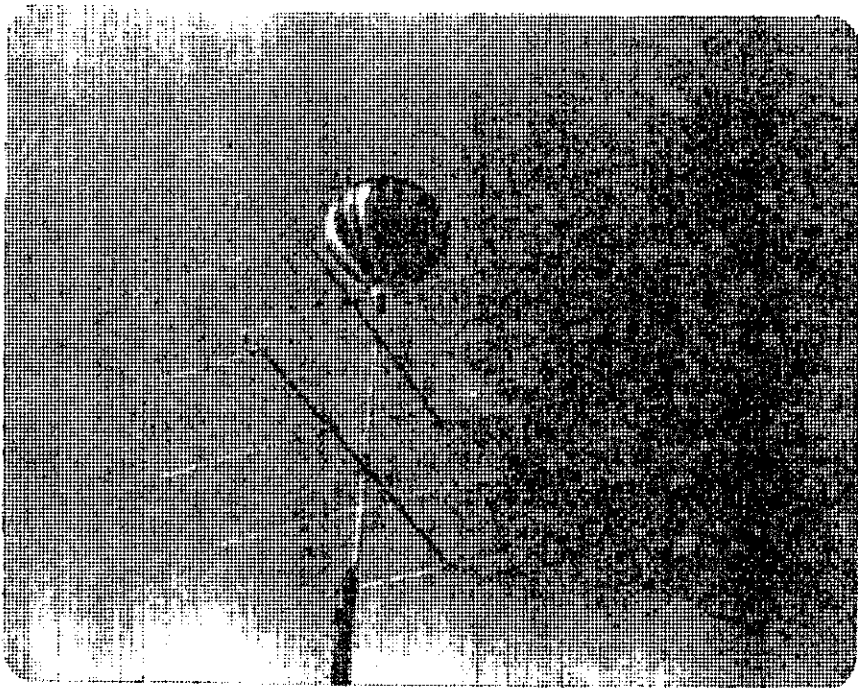
How about you are you willing to admit an error and share it with us, so that we might prevent a similar problem.

I went to a RACES team Captains meeting the other night. Herb, K6QXB and the Captains are putting a lot of effort into this and deserve all the help and cooperation we can give.

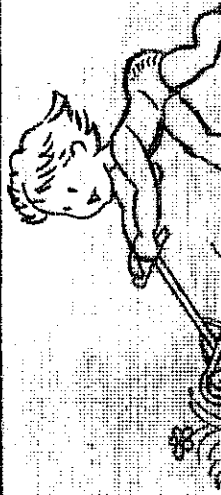
Don should be back by next meeting, so until then, 73, C U L.

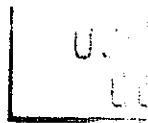
