ACTIVITIES: The CDF (Calif. Dept. of Forestry) classes were reported by Al. KD6NT, to be continuing on Thurs. nights.

EDUCATION: Spence WA6IXC reported that the 3 prospective Novices have now received their calls.

Old Business:

AND NATIONAL EMERGENCIES...

"FREQUENCY BANDS NOW AUTHORIZED FOR RACES USE IN WARTIME HAVE PROVEN INADEQUATE DURING PEACETIME DISASTERS.

IN RESPONSE TO THE DEFENSE DEPARTMENT REQUEST, THE FCC ISSUED A NOTICE OF RULE MAKING AMENDING PART 97.185 AND ASSIGNING ADDITIONAL AMATEUR (INCLUDING MOST OF THE 2-METER HAM BAND) TO BE USED FOR RACES DURING THE TIME OF "DECLARED NATIONAL EMERGENCIES". THE NEW FREQUENCIES WERE PRIMARILY IN THE VHF AND UP BANDS ALTHOUGH ADDITIONAL HF SPECTRUM WAS PROPOSED AS WELL. COMMENT DEADLINE FOR THE PROPOSAL EXTENDS TO AUD. 2 WITH REPLY COMMENTS ON/BEFORE SEPT. 1ST. ACTION BY THE COMMISSION, PR DOCKET 83-524, BY NPRM-RELEASED JUNE 3, 83.

HISTORIC AMATEUR SATELLITE LAUNCHED

ON JUNE 16TH OUR NEWEST AMATEUR SATELLITE, OSCAR 10, WAS BORN. OSCAR 10 IS THE FIRST IN A NEW GENERATION OF HIGH VISIBILITY LONG-ACCESS HAM SATELLITE AND THE FIRST TO BE ORBITED BY A NON-NASA ROCKET. THE PHASE 111B LAUNCH VEHICLE, THE ARIANE L6, FUNCTIONED FLAWLESSLY DEPOSITING THE QUARTER MILLION DOLLAR PLUS OSCAR 10 IN ORBIT 13 MINUTES AND 53 SECONDS LATER.

IT WILL PROVIDE UPWARDS OF 16 TO 17 HOURS OF WORLDWIDE COMMUNICATIONS PER DAY. THUS 80 PERCENT OF THE HAMS IN THE WORLD WILL HAVE ACCESS TO THIS SATELLITE FOR THE MAJOR PORTION OF EVERY DAY. THIS LOOKS LIKE THE LARGEST PILE UP EVER DEVISED. THE DX BOYS SHOULD LIKE IT.

THE GENERAL BECON IS LOCATED AT 145.810. OSCAR 10 HAS TWO TRANSPONDERS (BROAD BAND REPEATERS) ON BOARD. MODE B WILL NEED AN UPLINK RANGE OF 435.025 TO 435.175 MHZ AND BE ABLE TO RECEIVE A RANGE OF 145.828 TO 145.978. MODE L WILL TRANSPONDER WILL PROVIDE 800 KHZ OF PASSBAND REQUIRING SIGNALS FOR UPLINK BETWEEN 1268.05 AND 1268.85 DOWN LINK BETWEEN 436.15 AND 436.96 MHZ. IF YOU ADD ALL THIS PASSBAND UP YOU WILL HAVE A FIGURE WIDER THAN SSB ON 80/15 METER BANDS.

TUNE INTO 3850 TUESDAYS AT 9PM CST AMSAT INTERMATIONAL NET, OR SUNDAY 21,280 MHZ 1800UTC, 14282 MHZ 1900UTC. FCC FINALLY RECEIVES LICENSE FORMS

THE FCC SAID THAT THE LICENSE FORM ARIVAL DELAY PUT THEM BEHIND WEEKS. IF YOU KNOW OF SOMEONE THAT HAS BEEN WAITING FOR FINE ABOUT 5 WEEKS OR MORE FOR THE NEW NOVICE LICENSE AND CALL SIGN, HAVE HIM CALL 717-337-1212 TO OBTAIN IT.

FCC WILL RULE ON NOVICE EXAMS

ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 29, ACCORDING TO A OPEN COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA BEING CIRCULATED. WE CAN ONLY SPECULATE THAT THE FCC WILL ADOPT FINAL RULES THAT WILL ALLOW EXAMINERS TO FULLY ADMINISTER AND GRADE NOVICE CLASS AMATEUR RADIO OPERATOR EXAMINATIONS.

BUSINESS COMMUNICATIONS IN THE AMATEUR SERVICE.

THE FCC IS VERY CONCERNED ABOUT ABUSES OF THE PROBHIBITION AGAINST THE TRANSMISSION OF BUSINESS COMMUNICATIONS IN THE AMATEUR RADIO SERVICE AND WE UNDERSTAND THAT THE COMMISSION WILL ISSUE A VERY CLEAR DIRECTIVE CONCERNING THIS. MORE NEXT MONTH.

OSCAR 10 TURNED OVER TO AMATEUR COMMUNITY

AS YOU READ THIS THE SATELLITE SHOULD BE FULLY OPERATIONAL ON MODE E AND CARRYING MANY QSOS.

THERE ARE TWO TRANSPONDERS ON BOARD THE SPACECRAFT. MODE B (435.025-435.175 MHZ UPLINK/145.975-145.825 DOWNLINK) AND MODE L (1269.050-1269.850 MHZ UPLINK-/436.950-436.150 MHZ DOWNLINK.) OUTPUT IS 50 WATTS PEP. HAPPY SPACE HAMMING.

THE NEXT ROUND OF AMATEUR SATELLITES (PHASE)V) WILL BE GEOSYNCHRONOUS! IMAGINE, SPACE REPEATERS OPERATING ROUND THE CLOCK! IT'S NOT FAR OFF! WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE A PART OF IT? JOIN AMSAT - THEY NEED YOUR SUPPORT!

NEW FCC PRIVATE RADIO BUREAU CHIEF EFFECTIVE AUGUST 10TH, THE NEW HEAD OF THE PRIVATE RADIO BUREAU IS ROBERT FOOSANER, FORMER DEPUTY CHIEF OF THE PRB. JIM McKINNEY, WHO HAS SERVELD AS PRB CHIEF FOR THE PAST YEAR HAS BEEN PROMOTED TO CHIEF OF THE MASS MEDIA BUREAU, REPLACING LARRY HARRIS WHO RESIGNED.

FCC AFFIRMS ALIEN AMATEUR DECISION

THE BOTTOM LINE TO THIS ACTION IS THAT ALIENS OPERATING IN THE UNITED STATES UNDER A RECIPROCAL PERMIT HAVE THE PRIVILEGES OF THE COMPARABLE CLASS OF U.S. AMATEUR LICENSE PROVIDING THESE SAME PRIVILEGES/FREQUENCIES EXIST FOR THEIR LICENSE IN THEIR NATIVE COUNTRY. THUS, IF THE 2 METER BAND IS ONLY FROM 144-146 MHZ IN AN ALIEN'S COUNTRY, HE IS PROHIBITED FROM OPERATING IN OUR 146-148 MHZ SEGMENT OF THE BAND. AN ALIEN OPERATOR FROM AL COUNTRY WITH OUT A 220-225 MHZ AMATEUR ALLOCATION (AND THERE ARE SOME) CAN'T OPERATE IT HERE.

STS-9 SPACE FLIGHT DELAYED A MONTH

THE "HAM-IN-SPACE" STS-P MISSION IS BEING HELD UP UNTIL OCTOBER 28TH. THE DELAY IS BEING CAUSED BY THE (TELEMETRY DATA RELAY SATELITE) THAT WAS NOT DEPLOYED PROPERLY FROM STS-6 DUE TO A KICK LMOTOR FAILURE.

SAFETY ALERT--N6DOA--THE LARK--THE ELECTRON......
TWO RECENT INCIDENTS HAVE UNCOVERED A PREVIOUSLY UNKNOWN PHENOMENON OF SERIOUS GRAVITY.

- 1. AT DUQUESNE ELECTRIC, A WORKER THREW AN ELECTRICAL SWITCH INTO A CLOSED POSITION WHICH PRODUCED A SHORT LIVED SPARKING.
- 2. AN EMPLOYEE AT UPS FLIPPED OPEN THE COLORED LENS OF HIS WELDING SHIELD TO BETTER POSITION THE WELDING ROD. HE INADVERTENTLY STRUCK THE METAL TO BE WELDED, PRODUCING AN ARC.

BOTH WERE WEARING CONTACT LENSES. ON RETURNING HOME FROM WORK, THEY REMOVED THE CONTACTS AND THE CORNEA OF THE EYE WAS REMOVED WITH THE LENS.

THE ELECTRIC ARC GENERATES MICROWAVES THAT INSTANTLY DRY UP THE FLUID BETWEEN THE EYE AND THE LENS, CAUSING THE CORNEA TO BE BONDED TO THE LENS. THIS TRAUMA IS PAINLESS AND THE INDIVIDUAL NEVER KNOWS AN INJURY HAS OCCURRED UNTIL REMOVING THE CONTACT LENS.

AS THIS PHENOMENON WAS UNKNOWN, NO FEDERAL OR STATE SAFETY AND HEALTH AGENCY HAS REGULATIONS ON THIS MATTER BUT THEY ARE PURSUING THE INVESTIGATION ZEALOUSLY AND WILL RESPOND.

IN THE MEANTIME, IT IS SUGGESTED THAT NO CONTACT LENSES BE WORN BY ANYONE WHO IS POTENTIALLY SUBJECT TO AN ELECTRICAL SPARKING SITUATION. (FROM 10-4 ALAMEDA COUNTY SHERIFFS DEPT.)


