### DXING FOR THE BEGINEER

WELL YOU'VE READ AN ARTICLE ABOUT DX. OR YOU WERE TUNNING AROUND THE HF BANDS AND YOU HEARD SOME DX, AND YOU WONDER HOW DO YOU GET TO WORK SOME OF THAT GOOD STUFF. YOU ASK OTHERS AND YOU DISCOVER, THE MOST ACTIVE DXERS HAVE 60-80 FOOT TOWERS, STACKED BEAMS, AND 2 KW AMPLIFIERS. WELL NOW YOU'VE COME TO THE CONCLUSION DXING IS NOT FOR YOU. YOU CAN'T AFFORD THE BIG BUCKS. WRONG! NOT SO!

WHILE IT IS TRUE MOST OF THE LONG TIME DXERS HAVE FAIRLY ELABORATE STATION EQUIPMENT. KEEP IN MIND 99% OF THEM DID NOT RACE OVER TO THE NEAREST HAM RADIO STORE, UNLOAD THEIR WALLETS AND LOAD THEIR TRAILERS. WHEN THEY GOT STARTED, THEY HAD A MIDDLE OF THE LINE TRANSCEIVER AND A DIPOLE OR VERTICAL THAT'S ABOUT IT. MANY OF THE WORKED THEIR FIRST ANTENNA. AND 100-150 COUNTRIES USING VERY BASIC EQUIPMENT. AS THEY BECAME INTERESTED IN CONTESTING AND ALSO BECOMING MORE COMPETITIVE. THEY GRADUALY UPGRADED THEIR STATION EQUIPMENT ALONG WITH THEIR CLASS OF LICENSE. YOU SHOULD TAKE NOTE OF THE FACT, NOVICES AND ORP (LOW POWER) STATIONS HAVE WORKED COUNTRIES.

SO WHAT ARE THE SECRETS TO DXING? THEY ARE, TUNE THE BANDS, LISTEN, OBSERVE THE METHODS USED BY THE SUCCESSFUL DXERS. JOIN A LOCAL DX CLUB, CONTACT THE DXERS IN YOUR AREA. VISIT THEM, APPROACH THEM AT LOCAL CLUB MEETINGS, ASK QUESTIONS, PICK THEIR BRAINS. I KNOW OF NO DXER WHO WILL REFUSE TO SHARE HIS OR HER DXPERTISE WITH YOU. THEY WILL NOT REACT AS THOUGH YOUR ATTEMPTING TO SEIZE THE SECRET SCROLLS.

I CANNOT OVER EMPHASIZE THE IMPORTANCE OF TUNNING THE BANDS AND LISTENING. FIRST OF ALL YOUR NOT GOING TO LOCATE DX UNLESS YOU LISTEN. CALLING CO DX IS A VERY INEFFECTIVE METHOD OF WORKING DX. REMEMBER, YOU NEED THEM FOR A NEW COUNTRY. THEY HAVE MANY 6'S TO CHOOSE FROM, AND A UNLIMITED AMOUNT OF U.S. STATIONS TO WORK. WHEN YOU RUN ACROSS A DX STATION, DETERMINE HIS METHOD OF OPERATION. OBSERVE THE SUCCESSFUL STATESIDE STATIONS. NOTE WHAT THEY DID. YOU WILL FIND THEY ALWAYS SEEM TO BE AT THE RIGHT PLACE AT THE RIGHT TIME. DO YOU KNOW WHY? IT'S BECAUSE THEY DO WHAT I'M SUGGESTING YOU DO. THEY LISTEN FIRST, AND CALL SECOND.

# CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS by N1AL (To be voted on at the July meeting, July 11)

## INCOME DISTRIBUTION:

Currently the constitution specifies that "50% of all club income shall go into the Repeater Fund ..." with the rest going into the General Fund (Article X, para. 5). The problem is the definition of the word "income". For example, say the club holds a fund-raising event like the Marquee Theater night that requires an advance payment of \$750. This is paid from the General Fund. Assume we take in \$1000 for a net \$250 profit. A literal interpretation of the rules says we have to put half of the \$1000 (\$500) into the repeater fund and \$500 into the General Fund. The "fund raiser" results in a net loss of \$250 for the General Fund.

To solve this problem, a clause was added to define "income" as "net income" of each item after all profits and losses are netted out for that activity. The last 3 treasurers have had trouble interpreting this. For example do we net out the coffee fund each month or once a year? It makes a difference since the income is continuous but the expenses are intermittent.

I propose to change Article X to place half of club dues into the Repeater Fund with the rest going into the General Fund. It turns out this will make very little difference since most club income comes from dues and fund raisers, and the Board usually votes to place fund raiser money in the General Fund anyway per Article X, para. 6.

I propose the following changes in Article X, paragraph 5. New material is in brackets [], and deleted material is in strikeevers: The ellipses (...) indicate a portion of the paragraph not shown.

50 per cent of all club income [from dues and initiation fees] shall go into the Repeater Fund, the rest accruing to ... The word income shall the General Fund ... mean the net income of each fund.


