# MINUTES OF THE JULY, 1984 GENERAL MEETING (SUBJECT TO APPROVAL AT THE AUGUST MEETING)

THE GENERAL CLUB MEETING WAS HELD ON JULY 11, 1984 (ONE WEEK LATE DUE TO THE 4TH OF JULY HOLIDAY) AT THE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATION COMPLEX AND WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:33 P.M. BY OUR PRESIDENT, JIM, WACYM.

THE FOLLOWING VISITORS WERE INTRODUCED: N7FSV/6, JERENY; AND KB6FLU, WILBUR. AND MF-GRADE TO GENERAL HAS BEEN OBTAINED BY KB6EOC, BOB. CONGRATULATIONS!

### PROGRAM

THE PROGRAM TONIGHT WAS PRESENTED BY MOBEN, LYLE, AND BEALT WITH 05L CARDS-THE ART OF GETTING THEM, RATE OF RETURN, EIC. A QSL IS THE FINAL COURTESY OF A 050. FIRST YOU MUST HAVE A CARD OF OUR OWN. YOU CAN DESIGN YOUR OWN OR ORDER PRE-PRINTED ONES. THE CARD REFLECTS YOUR PERSONALITY, YOU ARE LIMITED ONLY BY YOUR OWN CREATIVITY. YOU NEED NOT BE WORRIED ABOUT DESIGNING A CARD AND THEN HAVING TO DISCARD IT BECAUSE YOU UP-GRADE. YOU CAN NOW PURCHASE PEEL-OFF, PRINTED LABELS FOR CARDS THAT CAN BE EASILY CHANGED AS YOU UP-GRADE WITHOUT WASTING PRINTED CARDS. THE PURCHASE OF 05L CARDS CAN BECOME EXPENSIVE ESPECIALLY IF YOU DO A LOT OF DX OR CONTESTING. IN THIS CASE, IT IS BETTER TO 60 TO A PLAIN-JANE TYPE OF CARD AND PUT AS NUCH INFORMATION AS POSSIBLE ON IT SO YOU DON'T NEED TO WRITE A LOT. RAPID RUNNING DXers PREFER THE INFORMATION ON THE FRONT SO THEY DON'T NEED TO FLIP BACK AND FORTH. A RUBBER STAMP WITH THE QSO INFORMATION CAN BE USED ON A PICTURE POSTCARD AND ARE RELATIVELY INEXPENSIVE. JAPAN HAS NO TWO QSL CARDS ALIKE AND THEY CAN GET RATHER RISQUE! (THEY LIKE THEIR WOMEN!). YOU NEED TO REMEMBER THAT NOBODY NEEDS CALIFORNIA QSL CARDS SO IT IS A GOOD PRACTICE TO SEND A SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE IF YOU WANT A REPLY. THERE ARE TWO EXCEPTIONS TO THE ABOVE: 1) SOMEONE WHO IS TRYING TO GET THE CALIFORNIA AWARD WHICH REQUIRES 200 QSL CARDS, OR 2) SOMEONE TRYING TO WORK ALL COUNTIES WOULD NEED SONOMA COUNTY.

WHEN WORKING DX OR CONTESTS BE SURE TO RECORD THE INFORMATION IN YOUR LOG IN EITHER GNT OR UTC TIME, AND REMEMBER THAT THE DAY CAHNGES AT 4 OR 5 P.M. OUR TIME. YOU MUST BE SURE TO HAVE THE PROPER DATE AND TIME ON THE CARD. THE OSL MANAGER WILL ONLY LOOK ONE MINUTE EITHER SIDE OF THE TIME YOU LIST WHEN CHECKING THEIR LOG FOR VERIFICATION.

SOME TERMS USED TO SEND OSL CARDS ARE:

SEND EITHER 1) VIA THE BURO, 2) DIRECT, 3) TO HOME CALL, OR 4) TO A MANAGER.

THE ARRL BURG SERVICE WILL MAIL OUT QSL CARDS FOR MEMBERS. YOU MUST HAVE THE CARDS IN ORDER OF CALL. THEY WILL SEMD OUT 125 CARDS FOR \$1.55. IT IS THE ONLY WAY IN WHICH YOU CAN GET A QSL CARD FROM RUSSIA. THE OUT-GOING BURG MAILS OUT YOUR CARDS. YOU MUST SEND THEM THE LABELS FROM QST AND THEY WILL ONLY DO IT 12 TIMES A YEAR. THE IN-COMING BURG MAILS THE CARDS TO YOU THAT THEY HAVE RECEIVED WITH YOUR CALL SIGN. YOU MUST SEND A 5X7 ENVELOPE WITH YOUR CALL SIGN IN THE CORNER, ADDRESSED AND STAMPED.

SASE - SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE. BE SURE TO PUT FOLDED PART DOWN SO IT DOESN'T GET CUT IN HALF IF OPENED WITH A LETTER OPENER.

GREEN STAMP - ONE U.S. DOLLAR (\$1.88). DON'T SEND UNLESS THEY ASK FOR IT OR YOU KNOW IT IS SAFE; MANY PLACES WILL PUT A PERSON IN JAIL FOR BEING IN POSSESSION OF U.S. CURRENCY.

IRC - INTERNATIONAL REPLY COUPONS = 65 CENTS EACH, BOUGHT FROM THE POST OFFICE; IT USUALLY TAKES THREE; YOU CAN PURCHASE USED ONES FROM 35-46 CENTS AND THE ARE GOOD AS LONG AS THEY ARE NOT CASHED IN; IF AN IRC IS OVER 3 YEARS OLD, IT IS NO LONGER GOOD. THE DX STAMP SERVICE WILL SEND YOU CURRENT FOREIGN POSTAGE STAMPS.

WATCH OUT FOR THE DEER WHO IS TRYING TO MAKE MONEY ON THE EXPIDITION BY SAYING "NO GREEN STAMP, NO GSL."

BENEFITS OF SENDING DIRET IS YOU CAN ALSO COLLECT FOREIGN STAMPS.

N7RO - CHARGES BUT GIVES YOU PERSONAL ATTENTION; SEMD 12 8SL CARDS PLUS \$1.88; 95% RETURN RATE; BE SURE CARDS ARE IN ALPHA/NUMERICAL ORDER.

DON'T IDENTIFY FOREIGN MAIL AS GOING TO AN AMATEUR OR THE POSTAL WORKERS WIL RIP IT OFF AND KEEP THE IRC OR GREEN STAMP.

### STANDING BUSINESS

THIS CHANGE AS INDICATED ABOVE WAS VOTED BY THE CLUB.



CITY OF LIVERMORE NEW ANTENNA STRUCTURE ORDINANCE..A RESIDENT OF LIVERMORE WENT BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL AND COMPLAINED THAT A NEIGHBOR'S ANTENNA WAS AESTHETICALLY UNAPEALING. RUMORS ARE RAMPANT THAT THE ARRL HIQ. PERSONNEL ARE IN THE PROCESS OF ORGANIZING.
SUPPOSEDLY WHAT GOT IT ALL STARTED WAS THE DIRECTORS DECISION TO REDUCE EMPLOYEE BENEFITS..
A LAWYER HAS BEEN HIRED AND A GROUP FORMED CALLED THE ARRL EMPLOYEES COUNCIL.

CABLE TO REMAIN ON HAM SPECTRUM. LATE W5YI REPORT.....

FCC AUTHORIZES HAM EXAM COST REIMBURSEMENT...THE REPORT AND ORDER (PR DOCKET 84-3220 WAS UNANIMOUSLY AGREED TO BY THE FCC COMMISSIONERS ON JULY 12th AT THEIR REGULAR OPEN AGENDA MEETING.

FCC CLARIFIES AMATEUR RADIO USE....AFTER THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT WAS CHANGED IN 1982 IT WAS MADE CLEAR THAT THERE WERE NO MORE SO CALLED PRIVACY PROTECTIONS FOR AMATEUR RADIO. THE SECRECY OF COMMUNICATIONS PROVISION (SECTION 605) SPECIFICALLY EXEMPTS AMATEUR AND CITIZENS BAND RADIO TRANSMISSIONS AS BEING CONFIDENTIAL. KT BECAME NEEDLESS, THEREFORE, TO HAVE VARIOUS PERMISSION REQIREMENTS THAT ARE PRESENTLY IN THE AMATEUR RULES. THE COMMISSION ISSUED A NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING ON JULY 12th TO TAKE THEM OUT. IT ALSO PAVED THE WAY FOR AMATEUR VOLUNTEERS TO TAKE A MORE ACTIVE ROLE IN POLICING THEIR OWN BANDS AND MONITORING FOR RULES VIOLATIONS. A TWO WAY CONVERSATION WHICH WOULD BE COVERED BY A BROADCASTER COULD BE TRANSMITTED AS PART OF A BROADCAST WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE ORIGINATOR OF THE COMMUNICATIONS OR WITHOUT GOING TO THE FCC. THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT WE ARE NOW ALLOWING AMATEUR RADIO TO BE USED AS ANY SORT OF BROADCAST AUXILLARY. IT IS STILL AGAINST THE RULES TO FILE A REPORT BY HAM RADIO OR TO USE IT FOR BROADCAST NEWS GATHERING. (FCC RAY KOWALSHI)

FCC AMATEUR AUXILLARY AUTHORIZED....ACTING IN CONCERT WITH THE ARRL, THE FCC'S FIELD OPERATIONS BUREAU (FOB) HAS AGREED TO IMPLEMENT A PORTION OF PUBLIC LAW 97-259 WHICH PROVIDED FOR VOLUNTEER ASSISTANCE IN MONITORING FOR RADIO WAVE VIOLATIONS. RECOGNIZING THE SELF POLICING ASPECTS OF AMATEUR RADIO, THE GOAL IS TO RESOLVE AS MANY OF THE PROBLEMS IN ITHE FIELD AS POSSIBLE WITHOUT FORMAL COMMISSION INVOLVEMENT. THE FOB IN COOPERATION WITH THE LEAGUE IS PREPARING TO ORGANIZE A NECLEUS OF TRAINED PERSONEL TO INDEPENDENTLY HANDLE MANY OF THE AMATEUR RADIO RELATED REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE RECEIVED BY THE FIELD FACILITIES.
