





April 4, 1990



The meeting was called to order by President John Wallack W6TLK at 7:40PM. Other officers present: Vice President Jim Pelmulder N6PTM, Secretary Al Bloom N1AL, Treasurer Phillip Gaul KC6BSI and Members-at-Large Chuck Sabin N6DDK and John Breckenridge WB6FRZ.

ARRL SECTION MGR Dick Wilson K6LRN presented us our Special Service Club certificate. He briefly discussed the FCC's no-code proposal and recommended we contact our new Director Chuck McConnell W6DPD with our comments.

The **MINUTES** of the last meeting were approved as printed in last month's *Short Skip*. m/s WA8LLY/N6PTM

The TREASURER'S REPORT shows \$1643.34 in the General Fund and \$463.64 in the Repeater Fund. Approved. m/s WD6CKP/WA8LLY

REPEATER: 146.73 is now using the Repco from N6PTM's QTH in Sebastopol. At noon today, repairs were attempted to the antenna system. There was nothing wrong with either the antenna or transmission line. The sensitivity problem must be the duplexers or the receiver. The County will check it out.

PUBLIC SERVICE Coordinator Bill N6GHG says he will need lots of help to fill Bob WB6EKV's shoes. We have 6 events coming up: The American Diabetes Assn event is this weekend. On the 21st is the Green Belt Alliance 400 mile ride. The March of Dimes WalkAmerica is on the 29th. We have 2 events on May 5th: The Special Olympics and the SRCC Wine Country Century bike ride.

W6TLK raised the question of whether we wish to continue helping with all these events. The consensus was yes -- they are good P/R for the club and we have not had a problem finding sufficient volunteers.

OLD BUSINESS: The Field Day plaque has been updated to reflect the fact that (we lost the Field Day challenge to REDX last year).

CATV QRM is being experienced by John WB6FRZ in Windsor. He gets strong interference from cable channel 18 (E) on 145.25 MHz and surrounding frequencies from Viacom's system. Even after they came out and fixed the illegal cable modifications at the house across the street, he still has problems.

The HOMEBREW CONTEST had 2 entries, a CB-to-10 meter conversion by Jim N6PTM and a complete microwave station by Bill N60LD. Bill's entry was the winner. Perhaps we can get him to write it up for *Short Skip*?

AMATEUR RADIO NEWSLINE, formerly called Westlink, is going belly-up due to financial problems caused by the legal expenses to defend a recent lawsuit. The club voted to send them the \$100 we already budgeted for the purpose. m/s WA6LLY/W6TLK

ANTENNA EXPERT NEEDED

Are there any antenna experts out there? I have several questions on the design and operation of loop antennas. I've had a lot of luck with full-wave loop designs for a single band -- both delta and quad for the 10-meter band. Now I want to make a 2-band antenna, for 10 and 20 meters, or possibly 10 and 15 meters. Conventional designs show the configuration in Figures 1-A and 2-A.

My questions are:

- 1. Can a two-band loop employ a common side? In other words, can I make a double loop that is not concentric, and that shares one leg for the two different frequencies? (As in Figures 1-B and 2-B.)
- 2. If the smaller loop is half the length of the larger one, will radiation occur on both loops? If so, will the radiation patterns interfere?
- 3. If interference does occur from one loop to another, would, say, 10 and 15 meters be a better choice?
- 4. If cross-coupling is a problem, would separate transmission lines help?



NIAL's comments:

Most multiband quad antennas I have seen have the driven elements fed with separate coaxes. Otherwise, the unused loops will mess up the feedpoint impedance.

A conventional one-wavelength-long 20 meter loop might also work on 10M. On 10M, it is 2 wavelengths long and should be directional in the plane of the loop (at right angles to the 20 meter directivity).



MARION ISLAND. ZS8MI has returned to South Africa.


ANGOLA. D2/LU6ELF ceased operations Mar 28.
