





# SCRA VEC Team's 1993 Summary

1993 was a good year for the SCRA VE Team. We had 3 testing sessions with a total of 57 people tested. Of those 57, 28 either obtained a new ticket or upgraded to a higher one! That is a 49.1 % upgrading percentage! Our team had its hands full with 89 test elements given. Of those 89 elements, 51 (57.3%) had passing grades. The following is a breakdown of licenses obtained: 2 Novice, 11 Tech, 7 Tech w/HF, 3 General, 2 Advanced and 3 Extras. Congrats to all of you!!!

The VE's who were there to give all these tests were: Jeff Moritz KC7VS, Claude Jones AB60L, Alan Bloom N1AL, Ken Kerwin K6UXO, Charles Masten AB6SG, Steve Lund WA8LLY and myself, Dave New AA6YX. Thanks to you and to all the others who helped with the setups and cleanup of the sessions. Without all your help there would be no VE program!

1993 also saw some changes to VE exam procedures. Now all Novice testing will be handled under the VE program. General licensee holders can now become VE's. The Novice and Technician tests were updated, and the FCC has dropped the station location from the license.

It is rumored that in 1994 VE's will have online modem access to issue new licensees at the session. That will mean a new ham will be able to get on the air immediately after passing the tests. No more weeks and weeks (or for some, months and months) of waiting!

Next year's SCRA VE Team schedule will be Jan 8, Apr 9, July 9 and Sept 17. These are all on a Saturday. Registration will be from 8:30 - 9:30 AM and testing will start at 9:30 AM. The first session will be at the Hewlett Packard facility off of Petaluma Hill Road in Rohnert Park in the "Oak" room. The April and July sessions will meet at the HP plant in Santa Rosa on Fountain Grove Parkway (the same room as club meetings). The September session is held in conjunction with the SCRA Swap Meet in Sebastopol at the Holy Ghost Hall. Hope to see you there!

Thanks again to all the individuals who helped and to SCRA for sponsoring this effort! A special thanks to Dale Westerterp WB6TMS, who gathered and organized VE Teams from Sonoma, Napa and Marin counties to provide at least one test session in our area each month.

# Antenna **Committee**

The matter of Don, KD6HQ vs the City of Santa Rosa was last reported in the July, 1993 issue of Short Skip. Much has transpired since that time.

# The Design Review Board

Don appeared a second time before the city's Design Review Board on August 19, 1993 and again requested that the Design Review Board grant approval of his antenna installation. Since the prior appearance before the board, Don had removed his 40 meter rotatable dipole and half of the boom and two elements of his tri-bander. This materially reduced the mass of the antenna and of course also reduced its effectiveness. Don presented photographs of the modified antenna to the board and explained what he had done. After hearing Don and myself speak, the board heard from the complaining neighbor.

After brief discussion, the board again rejected Don's appeal and advised him that if he desired to pursue the issue he would have to appeal their ruling to the City Council. Don elected to do so and filed the necessary forms.

# The City Council

The matter was heard by the City Council on Tuesday, November 9, 1993. I spoke verv briefly at the beginning of the meeting and submitted a four page document to the Mayor and each of the Council members which outlined in some detail our position regarding an Amateur's right to have an antenna and suggesting that the present ordinance was unworkable. I also offered the services of our association to the City staff to prepare a workable model antenna ordinance which, if enacted, would specifically outline conditions governing Amateur Radio antennas within the city limits of Santa Rosa.

After disposing of several other matters the Council came to the matter of Don's antenna. First to be heard was Ron Allen representing the Design Review Board. He reviewed what had transpired and recommended that the council deny Don's appeal from their prior negative decision.

### Don's Turn


Then came Don's turn. Don told them what he had done to minimize his antenna and why moving the tower would be prohibitively expensive. Don had also submitted written comments. Considerable discussion ensued. Our Mayor mentioned that there were several communications at hand including one from Ken McTaggart (N6KM). It appears that the Council did in fact take the time to read these communications. At times during these discussions it appeared that we were going down in defeat, but with an unexpected assist from the city attorney, Bruce Leavitt, the Mayor brought the matter to a conclusion.

### The Decision

The result: A motion stating that Don can keep his antenna, and of much greater importance, that the City Attorney's office be directed to work directly with representatives of the Santa Rosa Amateur community to draft a new ordinance applicable to Amateur Radio antenna installations. This was a goal that we had hoped to achieve sometime in the future so you can appreciate our feelings when we heard the motion. The vote was four in favor and one against the motion with Mr. Berto dissenting. This was not unexpected after hearing his comments during the discussion.

We now await contact from the City Attorney's office. I feel that we have been presented with a wonderful opportunity to work with our City to greatly enhance the ability of local Amateurs to have effective antenna installations and to do so with a minimum of red tape. The battle is far from over but things sure are looking up.

Our thanks to the many SCRA members who showed up to support Don's appeal. I am sure the Mayor and Council noted your presence. Stay tuned for further developments.



# A Situation Fraught With Gravity


Re your recent editorial on the dangers of ham radio.

He then wrote the manufacturers and respectfully requested replacement of the rig on the grounds that it was defective.

# **Correct Phonetics**

There is dramatic evidence of the need for all phone operators to know the ITU (International Telegraphic Union) standard phonetics.

When John K8COA took net control of a large phone net, a high noise level made copy difficult. He could only get call letters if given in standard phonetics. As the operation proceeded, he was shocked to discover many operators did not know the phonetics even for their own call signs.

The sole purpose of phonetics is to make yourself understood under difficult conditions, and the use of more than one set of phonetics defeats that purpose. It also sounds unprofessional. So discard the former Signal Corps or Navy phonetics, or old ARRL phonetics, (or your own concoctions) and learn the current ITU set. All phone operators who don't already use them, should devote a little time to the ITU list of Phonetics. It doesn't take long to learn them backwards and forwards, which is exactly what's needed.

Here are the current ITU phonetics:

ALFA BRAVO **CHARLIE DELTA** ECHO FOXTROT GOLF HOTEL INDIA JULIETT KILO LIMA MIKE NOVEMBER OSCAR PAPA QUEBEC ROMEO SIERRA TANGO UNIFORM VICTOR WHISKEY X-RAY YANKEE ZULU.

If you say them in order, in lines as listed above, the rhythm makes a jingle like the jingle that helped you learn your A-B-C's when you were small. Say the list sing-song fashion for two minutes, and do the same again tomorrow. (and the next and the next using license plates for quizmasters -Ed). Then start using the ITU phonetics and no others on the air. You'll be surprised how quickly and easily they become your "natural" phonetics.
