So, you write out a check and send it to the address that the person on the other end of the phone gives you, and you wait for your prize... and wait... and wait! If you do get one of these phone calls, rest assured, it is a scam. The taxes due on the prize are due only after you receive the money (not

Okay, I promised to try and let this be HAM related. So here goes...

One of the enjoyments I get out of HAM radio is turning on my 286 and hooking into the local BBSs on packet. One day, I came across a heartrending item on the board. Little Johnny Doe (not his real name) has a terminal illness. All he ever wanted out of life was to become a HAM operator, but now it seems that fate has cut short any hope of fulfilling this dream (sigh). If only you could send little Johnny at (fill in your own address) your QSL card, it would certainly lift his spirits. Yep, I sent my QSL in right away. I fell for it hook, line and sinker. Who wouldn't? I didn't find out until much later that the whole thing is a scam for an unscrupulous card collector. Am I an idiot? I should say not! At least, I don't think so! Well. I hope not...

We packeteers are always on the lookout for bargains on the BBS. I cannot personally say how many scams there are on these selfless services. But some do exist. really don't care about the QSL card (a minor cost), and I certainly do not wish to discourage trading among what I consider to be the most honest bunch of people around. But, I would like to advise the old adage, Caveat Emptor (Buyer Beware). If something sounds too good to be true, it most probably is. If something just doesn't ring true, steer clear of it. And while the fifty dollar tag on a two thousand dollar radio is mighty tempting, if you can't walk next door to test it, it just might be wise not to send your hard earned money to outer Mongolia. And, as for that bit about Last Chance to Send in Your Dollar? Well, if you really must, you can send it to me care of...
