### CITY & COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO DISASTER COUNCIL MEETING April 22, 1997

(from Eran KD6KVO)

Remarks by Willie Brown, Mayor:

"...I must also tell you that I have been frankly fascinated  
with that unpaid group of people with those ham radios, the  
Auxiliary Communications Service. Now they are maybe the  
most active of all the volunteers. They are virtually over at the  
office every time I go over there. And I suspect that they hang  
out there. Now they're an interested group of people.

"It is a communication system though, that I think now  
covers practically every community in San Francisco, and in  
some cases damn near every block in San Francisco, for  
emergency communication purposes, which means that a  
wireless system that seldom if ever can be totally disrupted by  
a disaster is within our grasp, and we are able to use.

"Obviously the cell phones play a role in that now, but the  
ham radio operators are the heart and the soul and the life  
blood of that system. And so we do have a system that is  
virtually communications disruptive proof in terms of being  
able to do the communications that we may need to do.


"There is also, I think, a level of training enjoyed by these

## STRESS MAKES YOU STUPID

A training seminar on emergency communications was held Saturday, May 10th. It was sponsored by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints (Mormon) and hosted at their building in Rohnert Park. Over 75 people attended from San Rafael to Ukiah. They were joined by representatives from the amateur radio community and county emergency organizations.

The theme throughout the day was that of preparation and training for future disasters. They learned that "STRESS MAKES YOU STUPID" and the only cure is practice and advance preparation. It began with an excellent overview and slide presentation of recent natural disasters. Included were displays from the Loma Prieta earthquake, Hurricane Andrew, and the 1997 Yuba City, CA floods. A frank discussion on the role of amateur communications in each event followed. There was much to be learned from the successes and failures in each incidence.

Participants then divided into several classes for more detailed training. Included were courses on the Incident Command System (ICS), programming and operation of various handheld radios, food storage and preservation, and even a basic lesson on how to earn an amateur radio license and what to look for when purchasing a radio.

Lunch followed and that too was a learning experience. Everyone was instructed to bring their "72 hour" kits and eat from them. Some deduced then and there that the survival biscuit/hardtack approach to nutrition and dinning needed to be reviewed! Many decided that MRE's (meals ready to eat) were not bad at all. A few, but not everyone, had seconds!

Several presentation tables were in the area where lunch was "served". PG&E utilities, amateur radio communications, Red Cross training, commercial food storage, and building a personal "72 hour" kit were on display. Almost everyone left with handouts regarding emergency preparation.

The seminar concluded with a one hour emergency training exercise. Attendees were divided into several groups and instructed to form their own ICS. They started with a realistic first aid/first responder medical emergency, courtesy of local Boy Scouts. What followed was an earthquake scenario with several twists and complications. Just what you would expect in a real disaster. A lot of

leaders learned to appreciate the versatility of having radio communications by their side.

Perhaps the most learning took place during a debriefing session following the exercise. Discussions were held on what worked and what needed improvement during the previous hour. Eyes were opened concerning the need to polish basic communication and management skills.

Was it worth the time, effort, and preparation? The majority who attended said "YES"! Another seminar is scheduled in November and a lot of the attendees are already making plans to be there. Maybe you could learn something from attending too.

I have been in contact with them for the last eight days and had set up a informal net of hams waiting with their fox hunting equipment and scanners hoping to hear the bird who had an attached homing transmitter. He was transmitting on 165.96 am. (no...he was not in pl ...he did not have his footwarmer on and I dont know if he has a KL7 call or not). At the time of this writing, we are all listening up and down the coast.

The Wildlife center now knows that we are a valuable resource for future releases of animals and plans to get us involved to track them.
